Piloting activities

28 teachers in six European countries got familiar into Start In eLearning platform's entrepreneurship pedagogy learning materials and have tested the Start In Mobile Application. Feedback has been collected in spring-fall 2019 by use of a digital questionnaire.

Gathered results will account for introducing improvements to the mentioned two digital project results.

Pilot 1. Feedback results were presented in a report by JAMK, School of Professional Teacher Education, authors Senior Lecturer, Mrs. Piia Kolho and Senior Lecturer, Mrs. Pauliina Silvennoinen.

The second round of piloting activities has finished provided feedback especially on the Start In Mobile Application, but also Start In eLearning platform. The information gathered until mid-2020 accounted for final updates to the two digital results developed within the START IN project.

Respondents remarked they have used both digital results, yet the eLearning platform is easier to use and that teaching with mobile apps is not allowed in some schools of the Consortium. However, as remarked, most interested are the interactive elements – videos in terms of the platform content and quizzes created in the mobile app.

Both results can be classified as transversal, applicable in different teaching and learning settings, enabling the creation of own content tailored to the needs of the target group.
